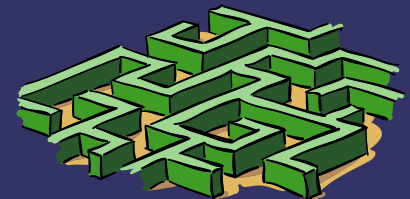

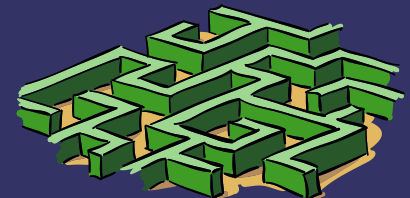

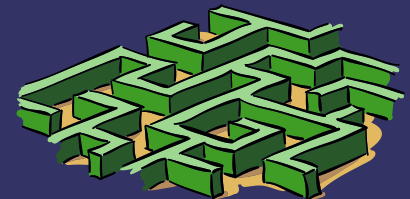
# *ADVISORY ACTIVITIES*

- rights and obligations of the job seeker
- placement options in the labor market through funds from the EU
- communication with employers - writing applications, resumes, calling employers, personal - contact with employers and placement options in the labor market in the EU Member States
- entitled to unemployment benefits (support) - this benefit social insurance



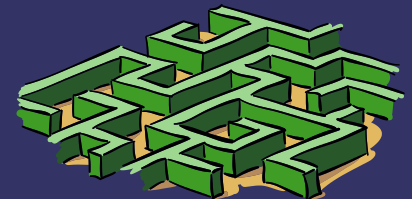
# *SEARCHING FOR THE JOB*

- \* by responding to the adverts published through the media



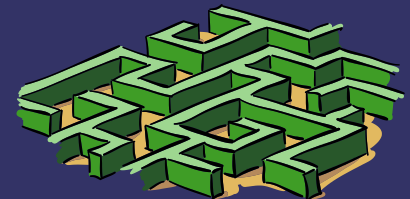
# *APPLYING FOR A JOB*

# *APPLICATION FORM / MOTIVATION LETTER*

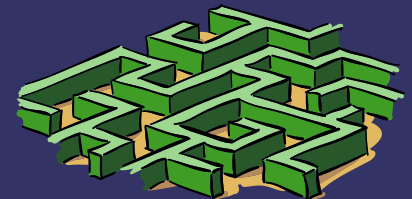
An application is usually submitted in the form of a letter, to which a structured CV must be enclosed, along with any documents specifically required by the employer, e.g. of education, special courses etc. Some advertised offers require the submission of a motivation letter and a photograph.



# ***CURRICULUM VITAE***

The structured CV is used in all cases, comprising personal data, information about education, professional experience, language and other skills as well as about personal interests of the applicant.

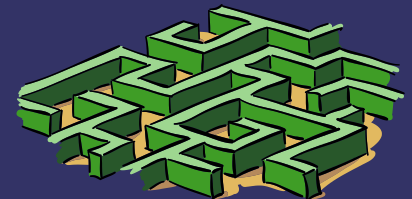
The CV should be clear and provide complete information about experience and skills. A holographic CV should only be provided when specifically requested by the employer.



# ***SOCIAL SECURITIES***

Everyone who wishes to live and work in Slovakia must participate in the social insurance system by paying following contributions:

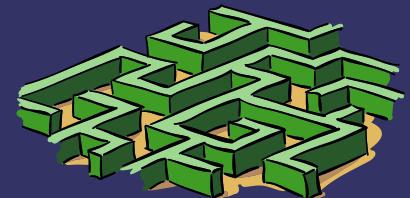
- ➔ Health insurance
- ➔ Sickness insurance
- ➔ Pension insurance
- ➔ Unemployment insurance



# ***SICKNESS INSURANCE BENEFITS***

Who may claim?

- ➔ Employees and self-employed persons subject to the obligatory sickness insurance who were recognized temporarily incapable of work due to a sickness or an accident
- ➔ The amount of this benefit is 55% of the daily assessment base

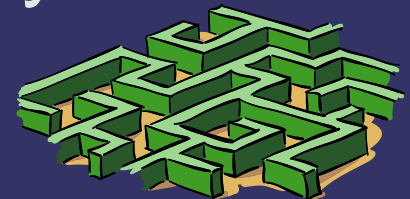




# *UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFIT*

Who may claim?

- ➔ The person who had been covered by unemployment insurance for at least 2 years during last 3 years before being entered in the register of unemployed persons seeking an employment.
- ➔ This benefit is 50% from assessment base and is payable for 6 months, monthly.
