

School's structure



The current system of regional schools in Slovakia are:

- Infant schools
- Primary schools
- High schools
- Special schools
- Primary Art schools

- Educational facilities
- Interest-educationalequipment
- School specialpurpose facilities

Primary schools

- For children from 6 15 years
- From first to fourth year of study constitute the first step of basic education
- According to ISCED classification at this stage is an important basis systematic study: reading, writing and mathematics, acquisition basic components of literacy.

Primary schools

- From fifth to ninth year of study constitute the second step of basic education
- Slovak primary school graduates would have relatively deep knowledge mainly from the Slovak language and Literature, Mathematics, foundations of natural and social sciences, ethics or religion and basic manual skills.

High schools

- General High schools provide general education and is intended primarily for students seeking directly to university
- Vocational high school schools prepare students to perform specific occupational technical, medical, administrative, economic, educational nature. The study lasts four years and is completed GCSE
- Vocational school schools prepare students to occupation, study lasts two or three years.
